Hokkaido is home to Okurayama Observation Deck, the competition venue for the 1972 Winter Olympics. This tour will allow participants to enjoy a relaxing lunch and experience the city's magnificent scenery, followed by a visit to the Hokkaido Ball Park Village.

Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium

The tour will start with a 30-minute visit to the Sapporo Olympic Museum, followed by a visit to the 1972 Winter Olympics' Sapporo Jumping Stadium. The Stadium contains an observation deck where visitors can enjoy the breathtaking views of Sapporo, Ishikari Plain, and Ishikari Bay from an altitude of 300 meters.



Nouvelle Pouse Okurayama

Located within walking distance from the Stadium, Nouvelle Pouse Okurayama offers creative cuisine reflecting the essence of Japan, made with seasonal ingredients from Hokkaido. Visitors also can enjoy the impressive ski-jump platform view from the spacious dining room.



Hokkaido Ball Park Village

The tour will then continue with a visit to the ballpark at ESCON Field, Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters' iconic stadium, established in 2023 as a new symbol of Hokkaido. ESCON Field features an impressive 70-metre-high maximum glass wall that lets in natural light and retractable roof that weighs 10,000 tonnes.
